Rules: All current NRA High power and F-Class rules will apply.
Eligibility: Open to all.
Entry Fees: \$70.00 for all individual matches (Matches 1-7); \$40.00 for Sat individual matches (Matches 1-3); \$40.00 for Sun individual matches (Matches 4-6). Fees include NRA registration (\$9 per competitor).

Entries: **You may pre-register and pay in person, cash only, in an envelope with your name, date, discipline and distance you will be shooting each day and amount on you are sending.**
Advanced entries are suggested

Entries are limited to 72 individuals.
Cancellations prior to the commencement of firing on Sat. July 22nd 2017. will be refunded in full.
No refunds will be made after firing commences on Sat. July 22nd 2017.

Location: Alliance Rifle Club is located on Route 43 just west of Malvern, Ohio
Squadding: Squadding for individual matches will begin at 8:00 A.M. Saturday.
Category: The only special category will be junior.
Classification: The NRA mid-range and long range classification system will be used for all matches. If a competitor does not have a classification they will receive a temporary log book from the NRA after the match, but will be classified as master unclassified (MU) for the match.
***THIS IS NOT A SLING/PRONE REGIONAL MATCH**

Divisions: There will be five divisions: Palma rifle, any rifle, service rifle, F-Class Open, and F-Class TR. Competitors must declare division to the statistical officer before firing begins on Saturday, July 23, 2017. Change of division after this time will result in ineligibility for open or aggregate awards.

Rifles: Rifles are defined in rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 for service rifles, rule 3.2 for any rifle, rule 3.3.3 for Palma rifle, and rule 3.4 for F-Class. Rule 9.1 does apply for each day, however a shooter may shoot a different rifle each day.
Any service rifle shooters that are shooting all optics will be classed in the any/any group.

Scoring & Pits: All competitors shall perform scoring duties.

Ammunition: Rule 3.17, provided by the competitor.

Targets: MR-1 and MR-1FC will be used at 600 yards,
LR-1 and LR-1FC will be used for 1,000 yards
There will be **NO** electronic targets allowed at this match

Challenges: A fee of \$2.00 will be collected in advance of each challenge.

Additional: The management reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any

competitor who endangers or interferes in any way with the harmony of the match. We also reserve the right to change the match program without notice if deemed advisable. Competitors and spectators assume all risk of accident and loss of property.

Course of Fire:

Saturday, July 22nd, 2017 9:00 A.M.

Match 1: 600 or 1,000 yd. **Any Rifle / Any Sight, and F-Class,**

Five sighting shots at 600 yards and unlimited sighting shots at 1,000 yards.

Any shooter that is not on their target with-in five shots will be removed from the firing line. There will be 20 shots for record fired in an infiltration block time with each shooter getting 25 minutes.

Match 2: 600 or 1,000 yd. **Any Rifle / Any Sight, and F-Class,**

Five sighting shots at 600 yards and unlimited sighting shots at 1,000 yards.

Any shooter that is not on their target with-in five shots will be removed from the firing line. There will be 20 shots for record fired in an infiltration block time with each shooter getting 25 minutes.

Match 3: 600 or 1,000 yd. **Any Rifle / Any Sight, and F-Class,**

Five sighting shots at 600 yards and unlimited sighting shots at 1,000 yards.

Any shooter that is not on their target with-in five shots will be removed from the firing line. There will be 20 shots for record fired in an infiltration block time with each shooter getting 25 minutes.

Sunday, July 23rd, 2017 9:00 A.M.

Match 4: 600 or 1,000 yd. **Any Rifle / Any Sight, and F-Class,**

Five sighting shots at 600 yards and unlimited sighting shots at 1,000 yards.

Any shooter that is not on their target with-in five shots will be removed from the firing line. There will be 20 shots for record fired in an infiltration block time with each shooter getting 25 minutes.

Match 5: 600 or 1,000 yd. **Any Rifle / Any Sight, and F-Class,**

Five sighting shots at 600 yards and unlimited sighting shots at 1,000 yards.

Any shooter that is not on their target with-in five shots will be removed from the firing line. There will be 20 shots for record fired in an infiltration block time with each shooter getting 25 minutes.

Match 6: 600 or 1,000 yd. **Any Rifle / Any Sight, and F-Class,**

Five sighting shots at 600 yards and unlimited sighting shots at 1,000 yards.

Any shooter that is not on their target with-in five shots will be removed from the firing line. There will be 20 shots for record fired in an infiltration block time with each shooter getting 25 minutes.

Match 7: Aggregate of scores fired in Matches 1-3, 4-6.

Shooters can shoot either 600 yards or 1,000 yards, either day, but will not be allowed to change yard lines with-in the day.

Awards:

Individual NRA Class awards:

There must be five or more entries in a class for one place award and the awarding of the NRA High Class regional award. Additional NRA place awards will be given for every additional 5 shooters in a class. Classes that do not have 5 competitors will be combined upwards to meet the minimum of 5 shooters. These awards are superseded by the Regional Championship NRA awards.

Regional Championship NRA Awards: Match 8 (F-class only)

Winner: NRA Regional Gold Medallion

2nd Place: NRA Regional Silver Medallion

3rd Place: NRA Regional Bronze Medallion

Regional Championship ARC Category Awards:

The following Category Awards will be given: F-Open, and F-T/R. These awards are independent of the NRA Class and Regional Awards.

ARC Cash Awards: Individual cash awards will be paid out for each match winner using the following format.

Match Winner: \$10

Category Winner: \$5 (must be 3 in a category)

1st place Class: \$5 (superseded by Match Winner, must be 3 in a class)

2nd place Class: \$3 (must be 5 in a class)

3rd place Class: \$1 (must be 6 in a class)

Range 1,000 yd. zero diagram


**ALL SHOOTERS MUST HAVE THEIR RIFLE ZERO
VERIFIED BY ANOTHER SHOOTER EACH DAY IF
SHOOTING 1,000 YARDS**

MANDATORY ZEROING FOR SHOOTING 1,000 YARDS

Sights should be somewhere on the center range flag.
Windage will be to the right of the flagpole.



The shooter and the scorer must boresight each rifle and sign the back of the score card.

1st + 2nd relays boresight before the start of the match. 3rd relays will boresight when they come out of the pits.
